

## Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs):

Can a foreign student eligible to take admission in India?

What documents do I need to submit during the admission process for UG Programme?  
The candidate has to produce original documents for verification and attach the self-attested copies of the following documents along with Application form:

- ✓ Marksheet of 10<sup>th</sup> Standard
- ✓ Mark sheets of 12<sup>th</sup> or equivalent examination
- ✓ School leaving Certificate
- ✓ Caste certificate (if belonging to any category as prescribed by Government)
- ✓ Adhar Card
- ✓ Front page of bank Passbook
- ✓ Transfer Certificate (if the student is belonging to CBSE Board)
